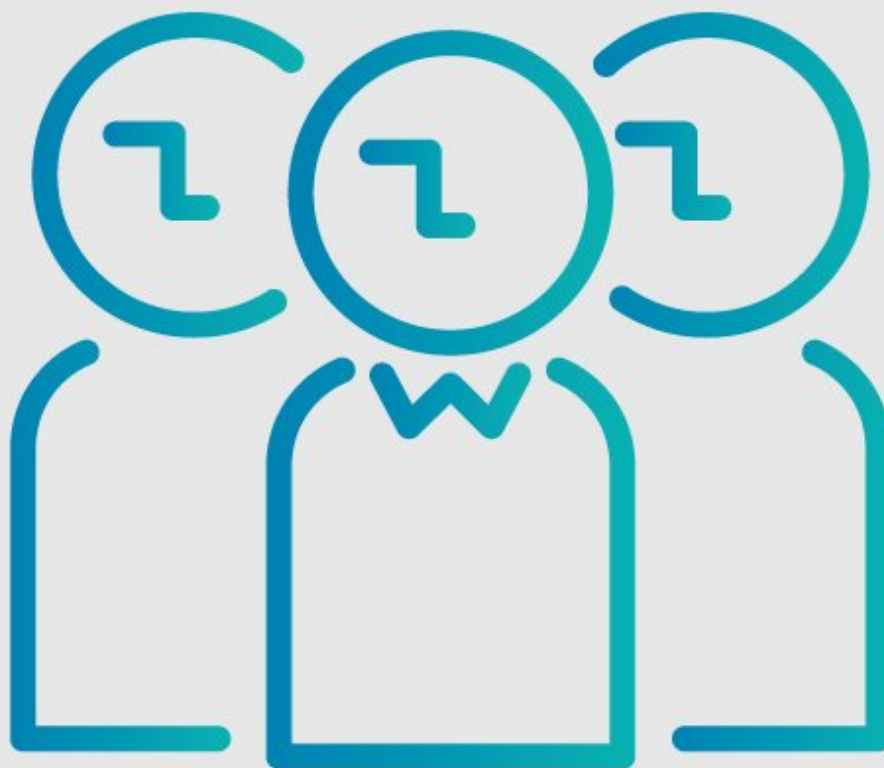




How to Create a Team

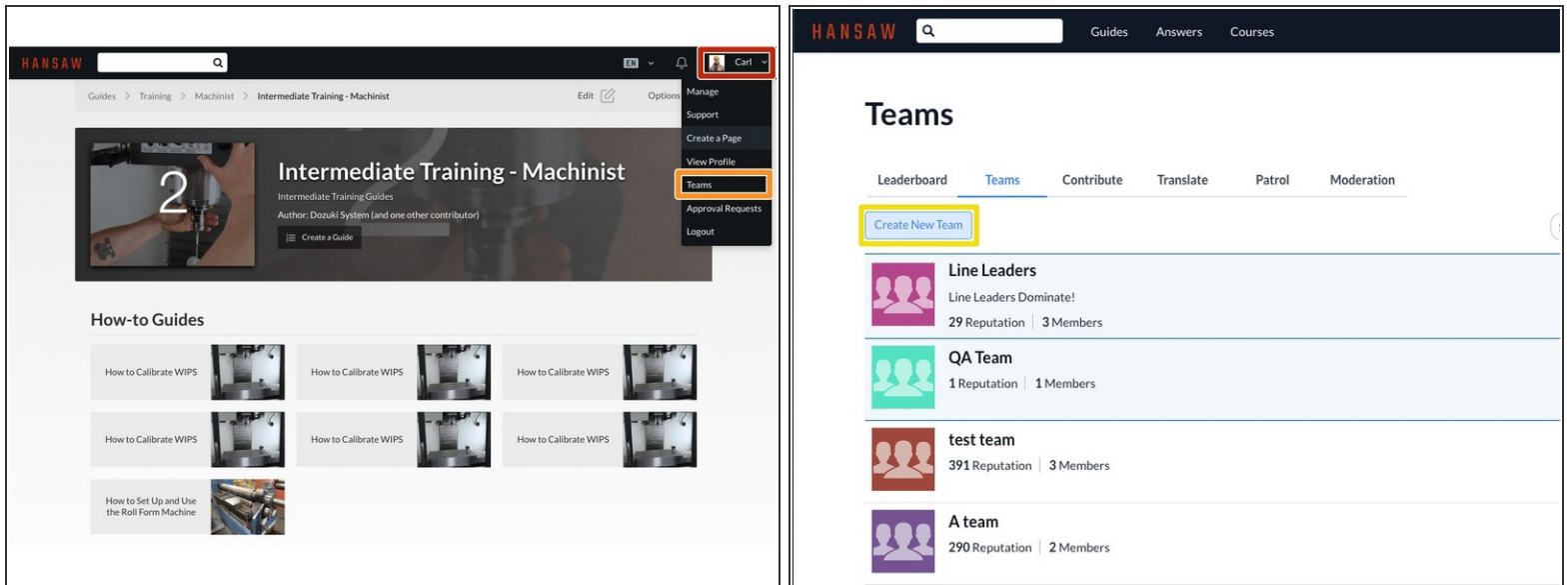
INTRODUCTION

This guide demonstrates how to create a team in Dozuki.

Teams allow you to segment your users into different groups based on similar interests, positions, responsibilities, locations, etc.

Once your teams are created, you can specify the guides that each team can view and sign-off on.

Step 1 — Open Teams Page



- Click on your username on the right side of the site header.
- Select **Teams** from the drop-down menu.
- Click on the **Create New Team** button.

- Add a **Summary** for your team.
 - ⓘ For example: Is this team comprised of managers? Engineers? Service technicians?
- You have the option to make this team an **Invite Only** team.
 - ⓘ **Invite Only** means that users must be invited or manually added to the team by an admin user.
- Click on the **Create** button to make your team.
