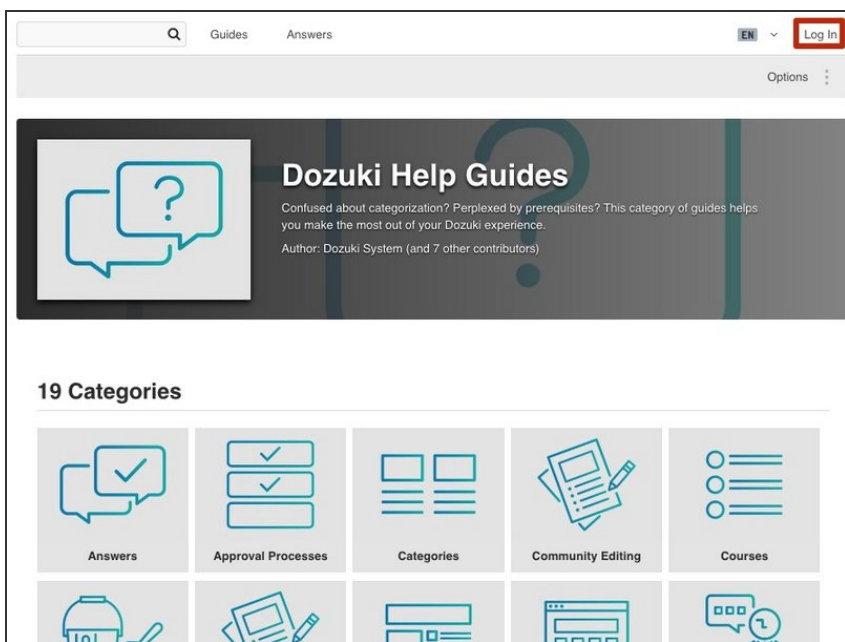

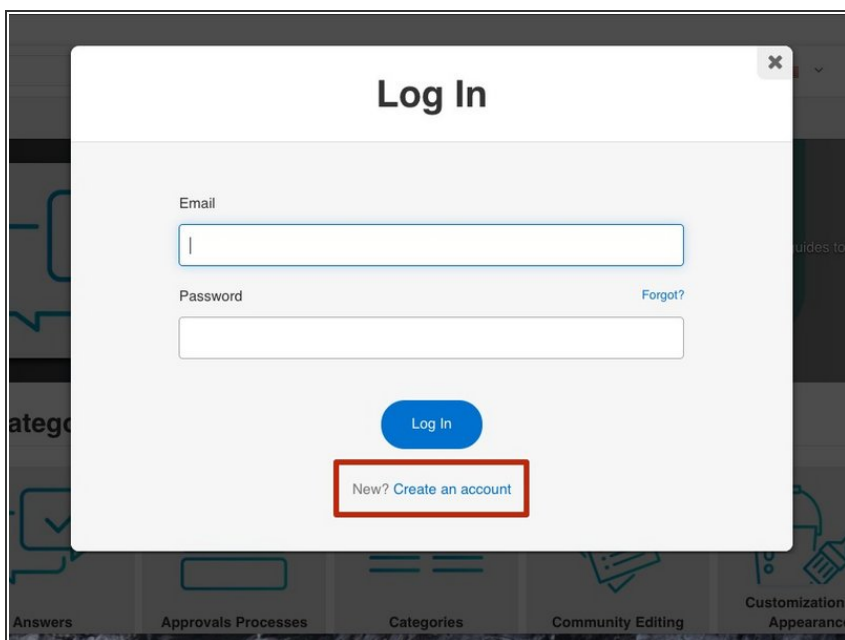
This guide demonstrates how to register for a user account on a Public Dozuki site.

Step 1 — Open Site



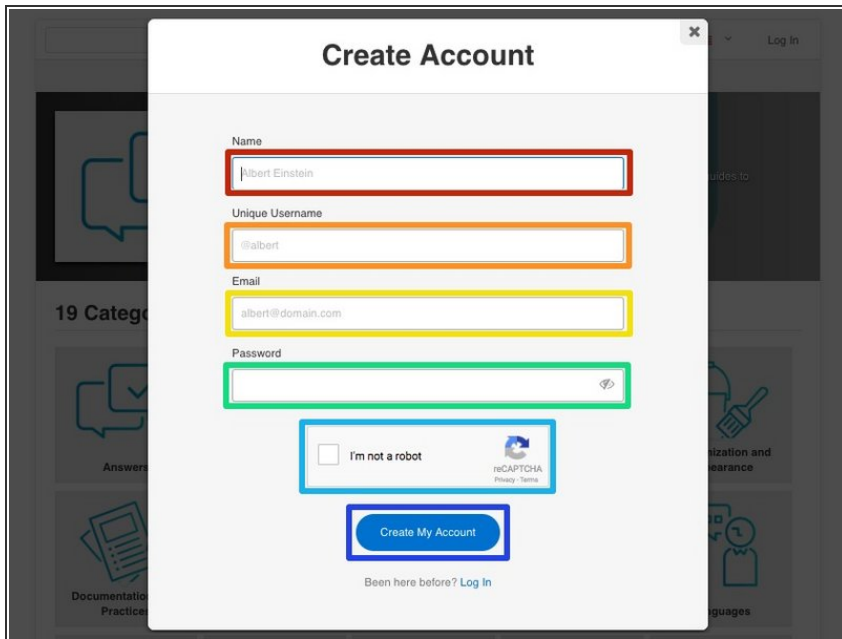
- Open the Dozuki site.
- Click on the **Log In** button in the right of the site header.

Step 2 — Skip Log In



- Bypass the login screen by clicking on the **Create an account** link at the bottom of the window.

Step 3 — Create an Account

- After confirming that all of the information is correct, click on the **Create My Account** button at the bottom. You are automatically logged into the site after the account creation.
