


INTRODUCTION

Requirements


- Approval Processes can only be applied to guides, wikis, or category pages if you have the
 <u>Version Control</u> features activated on your Dozuki site. Contact <u>support@dozuki.com</u> to
 request for these features to be activated.
- Only Site Administrators have permission to view, create, edit, and assign Approval Processes.

Step 1 — Select the Pending Release




- Open the guide, wiki, or category page that has a pending release.
- In the upper-left of the page, click on the release version drop-down menu and select the guide number for the pending release.
- The Awaiting Approval status will appear next to the release number.
- Click on the the Cancel Release button on the right side of the approval banner.

Step 2 — Confirm the Release Cancellation



- A confirmation modal will open at the top of the screen. It asks if you are sure that you want to cancel the pending release.
- If you are sure that you want to cancel the pending release, click Yes.

Step 3 — Verify the Release Cancellation



 The word Cancelled, the cancellation date, and your name will appear in the upper-left of the guide, wiki, or category page.
