

# INTRODUCTION


## Purpose

## Overview


Tags increase search popularity by including extra words that many would think of in relation to a specific wiki.

## Step 1 — How to Add Tags to a Wiki



- Open the wiki that needs tags.
- Click on the **Edit** button in upper-right of the page, under the site header.
- Scroll down to the **Tags** section, in the lower-right of the page.

## Step 2



- In the **Add Tag** field, type in the tag that you want to attach to the wiki.
- When finished typing in the tag, click **Add**.
